THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1 CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Order may be cited as "The Derbyshire County Council (A632 MATLOCK TO COUNTY BOUNDARY AND ADJACENT ROAD) (30MPH, 40MPH AND 50MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018 and shall come into force on the day of Two thousand and Twenty.

2 INTERPRETATION

"Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads.

3 SPEED RESTRICTION

3.1 Save as provided in article 4 no person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length/s of road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order.

3.2 Save as provided in article 4 no person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length/s of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.

3.3 Save as provided in article 4 no person shall drive any Motor Vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length/s of road specified in the Schedule 3 to this Order.

4 EXEMPTIONS

4.1 Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any Vehicle which is being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes.

4.2 Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to any Vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemption (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
