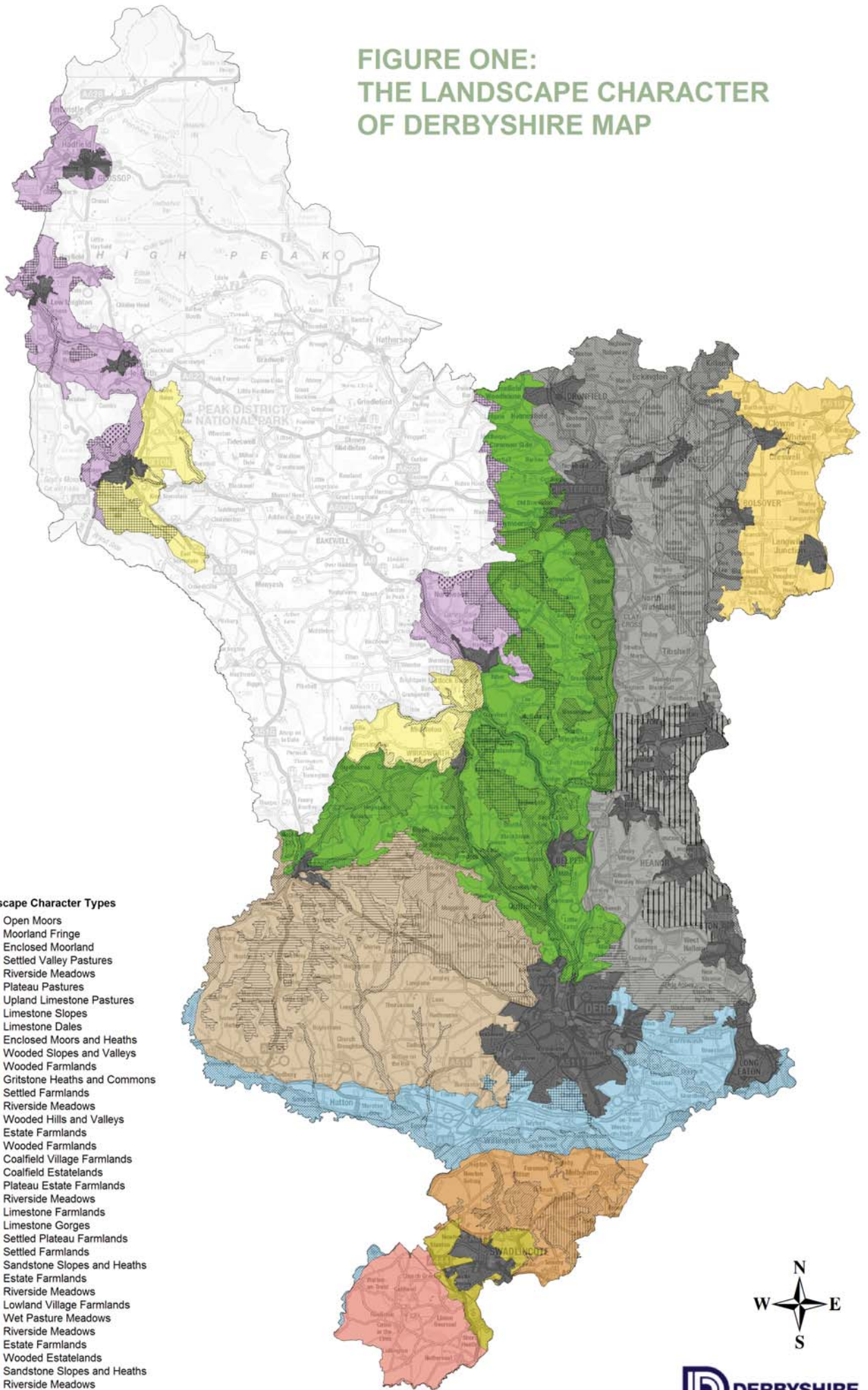


**FIGURE ONE:
