Elvaston's Gothic Hall at Elvaston Castle Country Park

Located in South Derbyshire, Elvaston Castle is a grade II listed building standing in around 321 acres of parkland, woodland and grade II* listed formal gardens.

Elvaston Castle itself is a **Gothic Revival masterpiece** dating back to 1633. The 4th Earl of Harrington had the hall designed and built in 1831 as a token of his love for his wife, the Countess of Harrington. The hall stood as a symbol of the chivalrous pursuit of love.

Situated on the south side of Elvaston Castle, **the Gothic Hall** was originally the entrance hall to Elvaston Castle. It was renamed by the 4th Earl of Harrington as **Hall of Fair Star** and today the mottoes 'Faithful to Honour and Love'; 'Gallantry, Courtesy and Love'; 'Fayre beyond the Fayrest' still remain.
