## CHARTED TERRITORY <br> In the days before satellites and computers, accurately surveying land for a map was a difficult process, requiring patience, legwork and a great deal of skill. Mistakes were sometimes made, as the surveyors themselves acknowledged. <br> 

 "These Errors cannot be cured, without spoiling the Plan."


Similarly, a 1792 estate map of Milford, created when the riverbanks were inaccessible, points out an error in the alignment of the River Derwent: "This part of the River was drawn by guess, before the Land on either side was bought or measured, and is all this wrong.


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
