What do Community Connectors do?



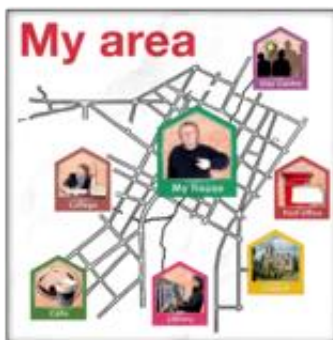
Community Connectors will work with you for up to 12 weeks. They will work with you on evenings and weekends if you need them to



Listen and work with you to find out what you might be interested in doing in your local community



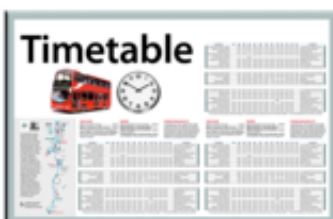
Community Connectors will help and support you to:



- Find local activities that you can go to for as long as you want to



- Find training or courses that are of interest to you



- Do travel training if you need it so that you have the confidence and skills to travel on your own using buses, trains or by walking a planned route



- Find work that interests you. This can be paid or voluntary



- Become involved in leisure and social activities. For example going bowling, swimming or making friends and going to a café together



- Make new activity groups of people who share similar interests



- Make new friends and relationships



You can use our service if:



- A doctor has confirmed you have a learning disability and/or are autistic



- You live in Derbyshire



- You are aged 14 upwards
